

Lower Urinary Tract Symptoms Revisited: A Broader Clinical Perspective.

The term "lower urinary tract symptoms" (LUTS) was introduced to dissociate male urinary symptoms from any mplied site of symptom origin, such as the prostate.

In conclusion, it is misleading to attribute individual symptoms to sex differences or to a specific underlying organ. LUTS are a non-sex-specific, non-organ-specific group of symptoms, which are sometimes age-related and progressive.
